

OUR TEACHING PHILOSOPHY-FLIPPED CLASSROOM

The Flipped Classroom System draws on concepts such as active learning, children engagement and interactive course design, and course podcasting. During class sessions, teachers function as coaches, mentors and advisors, encouraging children in individual development and team work.

The Flipped Classroom also caters to children with learning disabilities

Imaging the level of learning!

This is in direct contrast with the traditional model of classroom instruction, where the teacher is typically the central focus, sharing information during the classroom session. The teacher responds to questions while students defer directly to the teacher for guidance and feedback.

Students often try to capture what is being said at the instant the speaker says it. This makes it impossible for the student to find the space for reflecting on and digesting the knowledge being shared. Extending the knowledge to other frontiers is also impossible with this system. So, instead of knowledge being extended from generation to generation, it ends up being degraded.
